## OUR PROGRAMMES

### WICKETZ

Wicketz is aimed at hard to reach youngsters within areas of high deprivation across the UK. In 14 locations across the UK, it provides a sustainable cricket environment with a focus on social cohesion and developing crucial life skills such as respect, teamwork and self-confidence.

### SPORTS KIT RECYCLING

We collect recycled sports kit in the UK and send it to partners at home and across the world to enable more young people to play sports and join teams.

### DISABILITY CRICKET

The programme gives disabled young people aged 12 – 25 the chance to play year-round competitive cricket with their peers in a community environment. This inclusive programme focuses on the well-being of its participants, providing opportunities to have fun, socialise and improve confidence.

### DISABILITY GRANTS

We provide specially adapted minibuses, play and sensory equipment to special needs schools and organisations across the UK to give young people more sport and recreational opportunities.


### TABLE CRICKET

Table cricket is an adapted form of cricket played on a table tennis table, aimed at young people with a range of disabilities who are unable to play other forms of cricket. The focus is on teamwork and sportsmanship through competition, in an informal and enjoyable environment. This programme continues to grow with 38 of the 39 county cricket boards now participating.
