YOUTH AMBASSADOR

Join our team of Youth Ambassadors and share your experience of attending Lord's Taverners programmes, spreading awareness and championing the charity to a range of people.

You'll be part of a 2-year training and development programme, meet and work with other young people like you, and gain access to unique opportunities and support.

When is it/what's the time commitment?

This role is offered as a 2-year programme, so we ask you to commit from June 2026 to June 2028

This will involve contact with Lord's Taverners roughly every other month, in the form of a phone call, online meeting, or in-person event.

A big part of this role is volunteering at events where you'll share your story and help people learn about the charity. We'll always give you lots of notice about these events and you won't be expected to be able to do everything, but we do hope you'll get involved in as many as possible.

Do I need to go anywhere?

- Sometimes! Volunteering opportunities may take place online, in your local area, or elsewhere in the UK.
- Several in-person sessions over the 2-year period, including a mandatory induction event in summer 2026. The location for these events will depend on the geographic location of you and your fellow Youth Ambassadors.
- We'll have occasional online meetings – some will be group sessions with other Youth Ambassadors, and some will be 1:1 calls with the Volunteer Manager

What would I be doing?

- Share your experience of being involved in our programmes and the difference it has made to your life
- Participate to the best of your ability in training and development opportunities
- Keep in touch with the Volunteer Manager throughout the programme
- Attend online calls and in-person training sessions
- Influence changes that will benefit young people like you.

What support would I get?

- Online calls and in-person training sessions
- Support as needed to access the programme and opportunities, in line with your personal needs
- We will cover the costs of taking part in the programme or attending volunteering events, in line with our volunteer expenses policy. This may include travel, food and accommodation and we can pay these in advance if needed. If a parent or carer needs to attend so you can take part, their costs will also be covered.

Do I need any qualifications or qualities?

You don't need any formal qualifications, we just ask that you:

- Are aged 14 – 24 at time of applying
- Have attended Super 1s or Wicketz, at least one year or take part in Table Cricket or Softball Cricket within your school on a regular basis

- Are willing to commit to a 2-year programme of activities and learning
- Are able and willing to treat others with respect and demonstrate [our values](#): **we include, we empower, we inspire**
- Are open to talking about any support needs you might have.
